The North Central Working Western Horse Celebration, LLC, is comprised of several breed association competitions (AQHA, APHA, ApHC, AHA, IBHA, PHBA, & POAC) coming together with multiple equestrian discipline organizations (NRCHA, NRHA, & ARHA) to create a unique and spectacular event for the horse exhibitor, owner, and enthusiast. There is no other equestrian competition like it in the country. The various competitions fall under four main events.
