Additional bedding may be purchased during the show by completing a shaving request form and submitting to Stall Office located in Pavilion I.

**Entry Information:** Entries to are made on official master entry forms and must include payment. Cash, Check or Credit Cards are accepted. Please be aware there is a 3.5% processing fee on credit cards. There is a \$50 charge for returned checks or declined credit cards. Complete and correct information must be provided on each entry form. Entries must include current membership cards and horse registration papers where required. All exhibitors expecting payback checks MUST complete W-9 form on file with Show Office before checks will be sent.

**Arrival Time:** Horses may start to arrive beginning 8:00am on Wednesday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. Arenas open for riding at noon. All horses must vacate facility by 6:00am on Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Awards:** Ribbons, awards, and any other prizes will not be mailed. Any awards must be picked up in Awards Room located in Pavilion II prior to completion of show on Sunday.

**Camping & RV Parking:** Camping with electrical hook-up and water is available on a first-come/first-serve basis from the Alliant Energy Center beginning on Wednesday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. There is no need for a reservation. Camping in the North Parking Lot next to Pavilions is reserved for show sponsors and WW Celebration staff. Questions: Sandy (612) 868-0429 or (715) 558-5080

**Class Calls:** Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls.

**Class Conflicts:** Recognizing the schedule of an event such as the WW Celebration, every reasonable attempt will be made by show management to accommodate exhibitors showing in conflicting classes. Undue delays, however, cannot be allowed; exhibitors may have to choose which classes to enter and which to forgo. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify all applicable arenas of any potential or pending conflict.

**Damages:** Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to their stalls. Stalls may not be structurally altered in anyway. All damages will be billed back to the exhibitor. This includes hoof black on floor. No tape on painted surfaces. No posting on walls.

**Dogs & Other Pets:** No pets allowed in the indoor arenas. Pets are required to be on leashes or secured in the stall area at all times. Owner assumes all liability for pets.

**Discipline:** Show management reserves the right to remove any owner, groom, rider, or family member for any act of discourtesy to staff or show officials without compensation or damages.

**Draws:** Draws will be posted outside the show office in Pavilion 2 and by each arena in-gate. Post entries will be accepted but riders will go either first or last at discretion of Show Office.

**Fees:** All fees will be assessed according to each governing organization's rules (i.e. breed association reporting, drug, 9-90, etc). Judge's fee, video fee, & office fees will be charged based upon type of class entered and if classes are concurrent.

**Health Papers & Coggins:** As per Wisconsin state law it is mandatory for all horses originating outside of Wisconsin to have a negative Coggins with the past 12 months and a Health Certificate.

**Liability:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that the North Central Working Western Celebration, LLC, will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s), horses, or equipment.

**Lounging & Turn-outs:** Horses shall not be turned out loose on the property or in the arenas. Horses are not allowed in RV camping area. An outdoor arena is located past Pavilion II for lounging.

**Parking:** No parking is allowed in the immediate vicinity of the barns. Vehicles & trailers must be parked in designated area or are subject to towing and impounding at owner's expense.

**Refunds:** Refunds will be considered upon receipt of a suitable veterinarian certificate attesting to illness or injury.

**Ribbons & Show Moola:** Awards, ribbons, & other prizes will be offered in designated classes based upon breed & discipline specifications. Awards room is located in Pavilion II with hours posted on door. Show moola is for use in Celebration Awards Store, located in Pavilion II. Show moola has not monetary value.

**Smoking:** Absolutely NO SMOKING is permitted in the barn area.

**Veterinary Care:** The UW Veterinary Care Center is prepared to treat emergency and intensive care 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. They are located at 2015 Linden Drive, Madison, WI 53706.
